Our Early Years (EY) program gives every child the best possible foundation for students to learn at their own pace and stimulate their comprehensive growth. We follow a play-based Creative Curriculum which focuses on 5 different areas of learning that are equally essential for children's development within a learning environment that is evenly supportive and engaging.

The prime areas of learning

- Thematic-based units of learning
- Student-centered approach

- Experiential learning opportunities
- Purposeful, play-based interactions with the environment
- Experienced teachers and resourceful teaching assistants facilitate learning, as play partners, through play and interest-guided activities
- An emphasis on fostering positive relationships and the prosocial behaviours of cooperation, empathy, helping and sharing to boost socialemotional competence
- A focus on developing self-regulation skills, supporting memory development and cultivating a differentiated instructional approach for children at various academic and behavioral levels
- Confidence-building foundational concepts of literacy, numeracy, science, social studies, arts and technology in preparation for KG2's full educational day
